**TOSCANA** – This region is known as the epitome of perfect wine country, boasting some of Italy's most famous appellations.

**2011 Barone Ricasoli Torre della Trappola, Brunello di Montalcino 122.**  
Classic color with garnet hues. The nose shows ripe red fruit, cherry, spicy notes of liquorice and chocolate. The mouth is intense with well-balanced tannins.

**2014 Grattamacco Bolgheri Rosso, Super Tuscan 98.**  
From the famed coastal wine region of Bolgheri. The entry in the mouth is fresh and tasty, with a full and sweet tannic balance, the finish is composed and supported by its aromatic complexity. Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc & Sangiovese blend.

**2013 Barone Ricasoli, Chianti Classico Riserva Rocca Guicciarda 68/18.BTG**  
Intense ruby red in color with intense notes of red fruits and floral hints of "mammola" violets. On the palate, the wine is slightly soft with well-balanced acidity and tannins components. Persistent, harmonious and elegant touch.

**2015 Barone Ricasoli, Albia Rosé 49/13.BTG**  
A refreshing dry rose with a touch of raspberries, blackberries and violets. Blend of sangiovese and merlot. The 2015 rosés are simply delicious!

**PIEMONTE** – This region is home to more DOCG wines than any other Italian region. Named for its location at the "foot of the mountain", sits an ideal region for a number of indigenous grape varieties.

**2013 Santa Vittoria, Roero Arneis 52/14.BTG**  
Crisp, dry white wine with hints of pear and apricot and pineapple enveloped by an intense floral fragrance featuring lime and broom. Silky smooth.

**2007 Santa Vittoria, Barbaresco 85.**  
This Nebbiolo is medium bodied, smooth and dry, with fine tannins, juicy fruit and fantastic structure. Nice length on the finish as well. Delicate with a bouquet of roses and hints of red and black cherry.

**UMBRIA** – The lush region known as "Italy's green heart". Umbria's winemaking history can be traced back to the Benedictine monks, who were the first to plant vineyards in the calcareous sandy soil that extends over much of the region.

**2014 Cervaro della Sala, Antinori Chardonnay 89.**  
Luminous yellow in color with greenish highlights. The nose shows notes of chamomile, flint, and tropical fruit. The palate is mineral and the vibrant flavors fuse, with a perfect elegance, with the buttery notes and the light touches of vanilla.

**2013 Tabarrini, Montefalco Rosso 59/16.BTG**  
A blend of sangiovese, sagrantino and barbera that is satisfyingly original with earthy, herb-like tones from the Sangiovese, grilled plum and spice from the Sagrantino with a little graphite and floral notes from the Barbera.

**2011 Tabarrini, Sagrantino Colle Grimaldesco 72.**  
Full bodied with a core of iron-tinged minerality and flavors of fig cake, raspberry ganache, wild herb, olive and ground peppercorn.
